ACCREDITATION

Ibn Khuldoon National School is fully accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools since 1994 (most recent re-accreditation in 2016), and the Ministry of Education in Bahrain since its inception in 1983. The school is authorized by the International Baccalaureate Organization to offer the Diploma Program since 1990 (most recently reviewed in 2013). The National Authority for Qualification and Quality Assurance of Education and Training (NAQQAET) in Bahrain awarded the school a rating of "Outstanding" in September 2013.

THE COMMUNITY

The Kingdom of Bahrain is an archipelago of more than 33 islands, located a few miles off the eastern coast of Saudi Arabia. Of the approximately 1.2 million people, almost one third are expatriates. Many national and international banks, located in the capital city of Manama, have earned Bahrain the reputation as the financial centre of the Middle East. The international mix of people that live in Bahrain give the island a congenial and friendly atmosphere.

THE SCHOOL

Ibn Khuldoon National School (IKNS) is a private, non-profit, coeducational, and completely bilingual institution. The school is national in essence, providing students with a model of education that builds on the Arab and Islamic system of values while at the same time providing resources to meet the high academic standards of international education. Ibn Khuldoon National School was founded in 1983 and the first senior class graduated in June 1992. The total enrolment from grade K-12 is approximately 1605 students. The secondary school enrolls around 425 students and 49 teachers in grades 9 through 12 each year. The secondary school currently has a pupil-teacher ratio of 10:1. The current graduating class has 116 students.

THE STUDENT BODY

Bahrainis make up more than 83% of the student body while the rest come mainly from neighbouring Arab countries. The students come from an above average socio-economic background. With few exceptions, all students plan on pursuing degrees at the university level. All students speak English and Arabic fluently.

THE CURRICULUM

IKNS offers a standard American High School Diploma. In addition, the school has offered the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program since 1990, which allows students to be admitted to European universities as well as to receive advanced standing at U.S. and Canadian institutions. Students studying for the IB Diploma are also awarded the American HS Diploma (which is equivalent to the Bahraini Tawjihi-ya). All courses taken from 9th to 12th Grades were instructed in English with the exception of Arabic Language, Islamic Studies and National Studies. Therefore, all relevant textbooks are in English with the exception of Arabic Language, Islamic Studies and National Studies. There are 180 days in the school year, which are divided into two semesters. The schedule rotates on a six-day cycle of six 60-minute periods per day. All major subjects meet five or six times per cycle, and are full-year courses.

THE INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE DIPLOMA PROGRAM

Ibn Khuldoon National School has been affiliated with the International Baccalaureate Organization since September 1990. The first group of IKNS graduates sat for the IB examinations in May 1992. IB Diploma candidates must pass examinations in six subjects at the end of the second year. Three of the six subjects must be taken at the Higher Level, with the remaining subjects at the Standard Level. Higher Level subjects are academically demanding and considered to be equivalent to university freshman year courses. Students are permitted to take a maximum of four subjects at the Higher Level. IB Diploma candidates are required to complete a course entitled "Theory of Knowledge", write an Extended Essay on a topic related to IB syllabi, and enrol in the CAS program, which is comprised of 150 hours demonstrating creativity, activity, and social service. Students who do not fulfil all IB Diploma requirements receive separate IB certificates for subjects passed.

CALCULATING CUMULATIVE AVERAGES

Grade Point Averages are WEIGHTED.

The Cumulative Average (CA) and the Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) are calculated separately.

The Cumulative Average is calculated based on the weighted subjects' percentage averages, while the Cumulative GPA is calculated based on the weighted subjects' grade point for **years 10, 11 and 12***.

Course Rigour and weighted values:

AMERICAN HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA

Core Level Subjects

(offered in grades 9 through 12)

0.5 grade point is deducted from the Subject GP and 5% is deducted from the Subject’s Numerical Average when calculating Yearly and Cumulative Averages for every Core Level Subject. This is aimed to discourage abuse of the system. *For the year 2014-15, deductions will be made for grades 10, 11 and 12 results only.*

Standard Level Subjects

(offered in grades 9 through 12)

This is the standard level of rigor and is available to all students.

Enriched Level Subjects

(offered in grades 9 & 10)

0.5 grade point is added to the Subject GP and 5% is added to the Subject’s Numerical Average when calculating Yearly and Cumulative Averages for every Enriched Level Subject taken.

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE

IB Higher Level Subjects

(offered in grades 11 & 12)

1.5 grade point is added to the Subject GP and 15% is added to the Subject’s Numerical Average when calculating Yearly and Cumulative Averages for every IB Higher Level Subject taken. *Students can register for a maximum of four IB Higher Level subjects.*

IB Standard Level Subjects

(offered in grades 11 & 12)

1.0 grade point is added to the Subject GP and 10% is added to the Subject’s Numerical Average when calculating Yearly and Cumulative Averages for every IB Standard Level Subject taken.

THE REVISED WEIGHTING POLICY FOR IB COURSES IS EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 2014. THE LETTER GRADE ON THE TRANSCRIPT CORRESPONDS TO THE SUBJECT’S PERCENTAGE AVERAGE WITHOUT ANY WEIGHTING.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

In order to be eligible for graduation students must have a record of regular attendance and acceptable discipline. The total number of credits attempted is 29.5 credits. **The minimum credits required for graduation is 27.5 credits.** A student may graduate with one credit less in major subjects (other than Arabic and English) and one credit less in minor subjects (other than Islamic Studies).

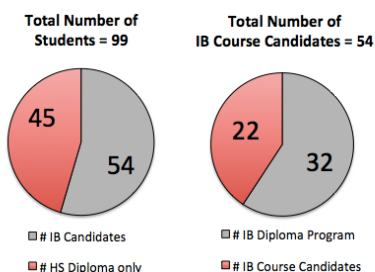
